### Camp Adair History

Judy Juntunen gave a brief historical background on Camp Adair, which was located just north of Corvallis in what is now known as Adair Village. Much of the information presented came from the book *The History of Camp Adair*. Some of the historical information that Judy shared with our club included the following facts: It was built to be a WWII training area and hospital for the military. At one time the camp was the second largest city in Oregon. It was built in a record 6 months and was a city for 40,000 with 1,800 buildings. 4 construction companies and thousand of civilian workers built the camp. The location of the site was chosen just six months prior to Pearl Harbor and construction began five days after the attack on Pearl Harbor. Camp Adair served as a military camp from 1942 to 1944 and house POW's from '45-'46 when it was closed as a military post.
